In today's world, scammers are getting more and more creative when it comes to inventing ways to target consumers. At Santee Cooper Credit Union, we want you to know ways to protect yourself from common scams.

Here are some things to keep in mind when it comes to scams:

•Don't share personal information about yourself such as numbers or passwords for accounts, credit card information or your Social Security Number with sources that you cannot confirm are legit. If someone reaches out to you by phone, you can always hang up and reach out to the company directly with a number YOU have on file for them.

•"Too good to be true?" If the deal seems too good to be legit, it probably is and you should take the time to question the offer before you give out payment information or sign any contracts with a company.

•Don't rush a decision. Sales and limited time offers are key tactics that scammers use to gain personal and financial information from consumers. Take the time to ask for the information in writing. Keep in mind that scammers want to put pressure on you so that you don't have enough time to really think about the situation.
